



Kayak-Umiak 20-krone coin

A Kayak-Umiak is the motif on the eighth coin in the ship series.

On 29 November 2010, Danmarks Nationalbank issues a new 20-krone coin with a Kayak-Umiak as its motif. This is the eighth coin in the ship series. The series will depict different types of ships, selected to cover various aspects of Danish maritime history. The Kayak-Umiak coin will be issued in an edition of 0.8 million coins in ordinary circulation.

Proof version – technical problems

The artist behind the motif

The motif for the new ship coin was designed by the sculptor Niels Motzfeldt, who has created a fine relief with a Kayak-Umiak at sea. The same artist previously designed the motifs for the "Three Brothers" and "Polar Bear" coins.

The new ship coin can be purchased from certain banks and via the Royal Danish Mint's website from 29 November 2010.

We will send out information about the issue of the proof version at a later date.

The next ship coin is expected to be issued in the spring of 2011.
